Benefits for Participating in the Challenge Pledge:

All schools participating in the Challenge Pledge will receive:

- Support from the sponsoring organizations to optimize participation
- Enhanced Data Reports from the College Board on student use of Official SAT Practice on Khan Academy, including minutes engaged and problems completed, by school and by grade level.

Schools that reach the following levels of student participation will receive recognition at the Michigan Official SAT Practice Challenge Conference (to be scheduled), as well as an electronic banner certifying their level – suitable for posting on district and/or school websites.

- Bronze – 70% of students participating, with at least 10 hours of practice and one practice test.
- Silver – 80% of students participating, with at least 12 hours of practice and one practice test.
- Gold – 90% of students participating, with at least 15 hours of practice and one practice test.
- Platinum – 90% of students participating, with at least 20 hours of practice, one practice test, and documented score improvements via school staff.
